BIASES AGAINST MOTORCYCLISTS:

- Many jurors distrust motorcyclists
- Insurance companies negotiate accordingly
- The right attorney can minimize unfair biases and prepare your case for trial



VALUE OF CASE

The value of an injury case varies from place to place, and depends on the facts of the accident. Valuing a case means predicting what a jury might award a plaintiff, and factors can raise or lower that amount.

The biggest factors in valuing are:

- 1 The extent of the victim's injuries and whether they are permanent
- 2 What juries in the jurisdiction have done with similar cases
- 3 The degree of negligence, identity of the parties and skill of the attorneys



DAMAGES TWO TYPES:

- 1 Economic or out of pocket damages: medical bills, lost earnings, lost earning capacity
- 2 Non-economic damages: scarring, disability, pain, inconvenience
